SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

FRIDAY, JULY 10, 2015

PRESENT: CHAIRMAN DENNIS BRINSON, VICE CHAIRMAN PETE STEPHENS, COMMISSIONERS DR. BUTCH MOSELY, GEORGE ANDERSON, RUSTY DAVIS AND RUSSELL SMITH, INTERIM COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR PERRY HENRY, COUNTY ATTORNEY BRUCE KIRBO, COUNTY CLERK BEVERLY KING, AND NEWS REPORTER POWELL COBB.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairman Brinson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. After the call to order, Chairman Brinson gave the invocation and all those assembled pledged allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

Chairman Brinson stated the only item on tonight's agenda is executive session to discuss Personnel and Litigation.

Vice Chairman Stephens made a motion to go into executive session to discuss personnel and litigation. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. A vote was taken and unanimously approved.

After executive session the Commissioners assembled back in the board room. Commissioner Smith made a motion to go into regular session. Commissioner Davis seconded the motion. A vote was taken and unanimously approved.

Chairman Brinson stated the Board discussed a litigation matter and no action is to be taken.

Chairman Brinson stated that the Board discussed a personnel matter pertaining to the County Administrator position. Chairman Brinson stated the search for a County Administrator has not produced any suitable candidates for the County Administrator position in Decatur County. Chairman Brinson announced that Alan Thomas, a former Decatur County Administrator, is the only candidate the Board is considering for the position of County Administrator. According to Georgia Open Records Law, the Board must wait 14 calendar days prior to the meeting at which final action or vote is to be taken on the position of executive head of an agency. The Board will schedule a meeting and vote on this matter in accordance to the Georgia Open Records Law waiting a period of 14 days.

There being no further business, the meeting, on motion by Commissioner Mosely, was duly adjourned. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. A vote was taken and unanimously approved.
