CLOSE PORTION OF WALLS ROAD

PRESENT: CHAIRMAN DENNIS BRINSON, VICE CHAIRMAN PETE STEPHENS, COMMISSIONERS DR. BUTCH MOSELY, RUSSELL SMITH, RUSTY DAVIS, AND GEORGE ANDERSON, COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR ALAN THOMAS, COUNTY ATTORNEY BRUCE KIRBO, COUNTY CLERK BEVERLY KING AND NEWS REPORTERS POWELL COBB.

Chairman Brinson called the Public Hearing on the proposed closure of a portion of Walls Road to order at 6:45 p.m.

Chairman Brinson recognized County Administrator Alan Thomas. County Administrator Thomas stated this Public Hearing is to consider the matter of closing a portion of Walls Road located approximately 0.55 miles west of the intersection of Walls Road and Cooktown Road. County Administrator Thomas recognized County Attorney Bruce Kirbo.


County Attorney Bruce Kirbo stated all legal procedures with this proposed closure of Walls Road have been taken; this Public Hearing has been advertised in the Post Searchlight and all of the landowners adjacent to Walls Road have been sent notices and that he has not heard back from any of them. County Attorney Kirbo stated that no one would be effected by this closure. County Attorney Kirbo stated once the Board of Commissioners approve this closure, this portion of Walls Road will be put out for bids.

Chairman Brinson opened the meeting for any comments by the public.

Commissioner Davis stated he was familiar with this area and that it would not effect anyone if the Board of Commissioners approve to close this portion of Walls Road.
