

AFFIDAVIT OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETING LAW (O.C.G.A 50-14-4(b))

Now comes Keith D. Sellars, after having been duly sworn, and state the following:

1.

I am the duly elected Chairman of the Decatur County Board of Elections and Registration.

2.

In the capacity of Chairman, I presided over a hearing of the Decatur County Board of Elections and Registration meeting held on October 11, 2019.

After having been advised that a matter needed to be brought before the Board, and that the subject matter fell within an exception to the Open Meetings Law, as provided in O.C.G.G. 50-14-2(1) (litigation) and O.C.G.A. 50-14-3 (6) (personnel), the board voted to close said meeting to the public, and go into executive session.



That the closed session of the meeting was devoted to matters coming within the exception to the open meeting law; said exception defined by O.C.G.A. 50-14-2 (1) and O.C.G.A. 50-14-3 (6): The Board unanimously passed a motion to go into executive session to consider the qualifications of City Council Candidate Ted Lee.

The Board returned 20 minutes later and ruled City Council Candidate Ted Lee was not qualified to run nor hold public office after the board determined that his prior crimes constituted moral turpitude, and his right to hold public office had never been restored.

Further, that no other matters were discussed in the closed session of the meeting.


