In the capacity of Chairman, I presided over the regularly scheduled and announced Decatur County Board of Elections and Registration meeting held on September 12, 2017.

3.


After having been advised that a matter needed to be brought before the Board, and that the subject matter fell within an exception to the Open Meetings Law, as provided in O.C.G.G. 50-14-2(1) (litigation) and O.C.G.A. 50-14-3 (6) (personnel), the board voted to close said meeting to the public, and go into executive session.

That the closed session of the meeting was devoted to matters coming within the exception to the open meeting law; said exception defined by O.C.G.A. 50-14-2 (1) and O.C.G.A. 50-14-3, (6). The board discussed employee dissatisfaction that other county staff was changing board directives. The board formulate a motion authorizing the chair to discuss this matter with the other county entities and for those entities to address any concerns about board of election staff with the board directly and not board of elections staff.

Further, that no other matters were discussed in the closed session of the meeting.
