

AFFIDAVIT OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETING LAW (O.C.G.A 50-14-4(b))

Now comes Willie Lamb Jr., after having been duly sworn, and state the following:

1.

I am the duly elected Chairman of the Decatur County Board of Elections and Registration.

2.

In the capacity of Chairman, I presided over the regularly scheduled and announced Decatur County Board of Elections and Registration meeting held on September 11, 2018.

3.

After having been advised that a matter needed to be brought before the Board, and that the subject matter fell within an exception to the Open Meetings Law, as provided in O.C.G.G. 50-14-2(1) (litigation) and O.C.G.A. 50-14-3 (6) (personnel), the board voted to close said meeting to the public, and go into executive session.

4.

That the closed session of the meeting was devoted to matters coming within the exception to the open meeting law; said exception defined by O.C.G.A. 50-14-2 (1) and O.C.G.A. 50-14-3 (6): The Board unanimously passed a motion to go into executive session to consider disciplinary action concerning the handling of provisional ballots.

The Board returned 20 minutes later to direct the Chief Elections Official to stress during poll worker training the procedures for issuing provisional ballots and the implications that denying a voter the right to vote could have on our county and board, and to discuss possible repercussions if policy is violated.

Further, that no other matters were discussed in the closed session of the meeting.
