Hurricane Michael Homeowner Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program



Do you have unmet housing needs due to Hurricane Michael?

To assist the most vulnerable families in their recovery efforts, Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) developed the Homeowner Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program (HRRP) to meet housing needs and provide safe, secure, and disaster resistant housing for residents impacted by hurricane Michael in 2018.

What counties are eligible?

The program will be available to homeowners with damaged primary residences in the following counties:

What assistance is being offered?

The program will address rehabilitation, reconstruction, or replacement, and/or elevation of existing or destroyed housing units.

The Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) has been allocated \$10 million in Community Development Block Grants for Disaster family homes that were damaged by Hurricane Michael. To be eligible for this program, the home must be the owner's primary residence, have unrepaired damages from Hurricane Michael, and homes must be in an eligible county. Applications are anticipated to outnumber available funds, so apply quicky!

Who should apply?

The program will be available to single-family homeowners who owned the property at the time of the disaster and were using the home as their primary residence.

Households that meet the low-to-moderate income (LMI) threshold or have household members who are elderly (over 62), children (under 18), or disabled will receive prioritized application processing for the first 45 days, but all homeowners are encouraged to apply immediately. Households that do not meet the above criteria will be considered for eligibility in order of application submission.

What will you need?

Applicants will be required to provide various documentation related to residence and those who occupy. This may include but is not limited to the following:

- Proof and verification of home ownership information
- Proof and verification of household composition
- Proof and verification of identification
- Proof and verification of income information
