The Board was in favor of supporting the Mask Up Program.

**Consider Equipment Transfer to Southern Regional Technical College.** Chairman Stephens recognized County Administrator Thomas. County Administrator Thomas stated that the Decatur County Sheriff's Office was requesting to transfer some old unused blue light accessories to Southern Regional Technical College. County Administrator Thomas recommended to the Board to approve the Equipment Transfer to Southern Regional Technical College based on the request from the Sheriff's Office. Vice Chairman Brinson made the motion to approve the Equipment Transfer to Southern Regional Technical College. Commissioner Brock seconded the motion. A vote was taken and unanimously approved.

Commissioner Davis made the motion to approve the Transfer of the Surplus Vehicle. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. A vote was taken and unanimously approved
