Consider Bid Approval to Purchase Fire Truck – AFG Grant Funds. Chairman Stephens recognized Fire Chief Charlie McCann who stated Decatur County Fire Department was awarded a FEMA grant in the amount of \$350,000 to purchase a fire truck. Decatur County would be required to match the federal funds of 10%, which means Decatur County's portion would be \$31,818.18 and the federal funds received would be \$318,181.82. Chief McCann stated bid requests were advertised and provided to various vendors for the fire truck with Fire Line, E-One Manufacturing being the low bidder with a price of \$354,668 and a delivery date of 180-210 days and recommends to the Board to approve the purchase. Commissioner Brock made a motion to approve the purchase of the fire truck. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. A vote was taken and unanimously approved.

Consider Approval for Restaurant License-Handyway/Super B #3 – Tisha Fowler Barnard 1572 Newton Road. Chairman Stephens recognized County Administrator Thomas who stated Tisha Fowler Goodman had met all the requirements for approval of a restaurant license and recommended approval to the Board. Commissioner Davis made a motion to approve the restaurant license. Commissioner Brock seconded the motion. A vote was taken and unanimously approved.

Daniel Aaron Goodman - 3225 Faceville Hwy. Chairman Stephens recognized County Administrator Thomas who stated Daniel Aaron Goodman had met all the requirements for approval of a restaurant license and recommended approval to the Board. Commissioner Brock made a motion to approve the restaurant license. Vice Chairman Brinson seconded the motion. A vote was taken and unanimously approved.
