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Call Special Election Question

Pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Decatur County Board of Commissioners dated January 11, 2022, and said resolution being on file in the minutes of the Decatur County Board of Commissioners and,

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 21-2-540 and § 21-2-541, there is hereby called a special election to be held on Tuesday, May 24, 2022, to determine by the voters of Decatur County, Georgia, whether to impose a one percent (1%) sales and use tax for a period of time not to exceed five years and for the raising of not more than an estimated amount of \$25,000,000 for transportation purposes.

Persons wishing to register to vote in this special election must do so by April 25, 2022.

You will vote “YES” or “NO” on the following question:

Shall a special one percent sales and use tax be imposed in the special district consisting of Decatur County for a period of time not to exceed five years and for the raising of not more than an estimated amount of \$25,000,000 for transportation purposes?

Decatur County – Proposed projects and equipment totaling \$15,402,500.00 include the following: Paving 2.50 miles of Cedar Grove Road, 3.1 miles of Bower Station Road, and 0.75 of a mile for Bailey Road; Replace large pipes on Kemp Road with a concrete bridge; Widen and resurface Country Club road; Resurface 5.3 miles of Eula Mills/New Home Church Road, 3.92 miles on Mars Hill Church Road, 1.41 miles on Mills Road, 2.0 miles on Phillip Pope Road, 3.10 miles on Cyrene Road, 1.0 miles on Hines Perkins Road; 1.4 miles on Kemp Road; 0.80 of a mile on Johnny Gordon Road and 0.70 of a mile on Gainey Road; purchase and replace equipment over a five-year capital improvement program; and, airport improvements and equipment.


City of Bainbridge – Proposed projects and equipment totaling \$8,750,000.00 to include \$4,988,332.00 for various resurfacing projects, \$1,659,144.00 for road and right-of-way maintenance, \$650,000.00 for stormwater projects and matching funds, \$552,524.00 for equipment purchases, and \$900,000.00 for equipment debt service.

City of Attapulgus – Proposed projects and equipment totaling \$402,500.00 include the following: Pave 0.3 of a mile of Boyett Circle, 0.2 of a mile of North Main Street, 0.3 of a mile

of Tobacco Road, 0.3 of a mile of Wood Street, and 0.3 of a mile of Woodland Avenue; drainage control and surface water projects such as purchase land for water retention, install culvert pipes, catch basins and close in ditches; and, purchase of various equipment.

Town of Brinson – Proposed projects totaling \$192,500.00 including resurface, repair and maintenance for 0.4 of a mile for Wainhurst Street, 0.3 miles of South Leon Street; 0.2 of a mile for Gordon Street, 0.3 of a mile for McNair Street, 0.35 of a mile Third Street and 0.3 of a mile for North Leon Street.

City of Climax – Proposed projects totaling \$252,500.00 include the following: Resurface Pecan Street, MLK/Cloud Street, Bradley Street, Railroad Street, Madison Street, Lee Street and Jeter Street; purchase DOT-approved street signs and regulatory signs, traffic and repair signs and associated mounting hardware; center-line striping, double yellow line and white edge lines if required; and, purchase maintenance vehicles.
